The East Surrey Rural Transport Partnership, a community transport charity, is operating a fast, reliable commuter service to link residents of Buckland, Betchworth, Brockham and Strood Green with Dorking Main Station during the busy morning and evening rush-hour period.

The service operates on Mondays to Fridays excluding public holidays.

Our driver will pick up from various bus-stops in your village and take you to the train station and then back home again in the evening.

Save on:

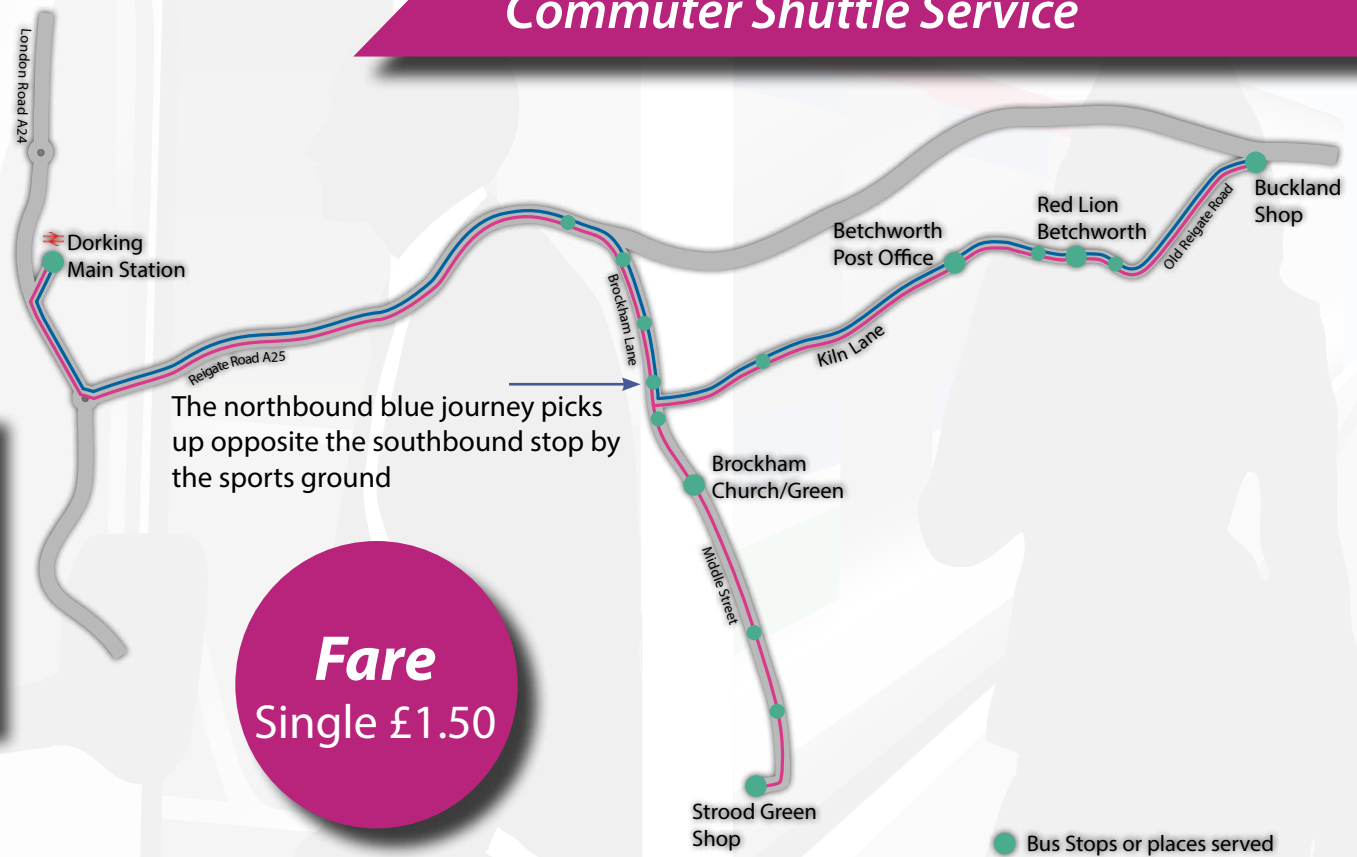
- Car parking costs.
